COPYRIGHT CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE FOR BROADCASTERS AND CONTENT SERVICE PROVIDERS

The Kenya Copyright Board (KECOBO) is a State Corporation established under Section 3 of the Copyright Act to administer and enforce copyright and related rights in Kenya.

KECOBO has been mandated by the Communication Authority of Kenya (CA) to process Copyright Clearance Certificate to Broadcasters and Content Service Providers in line with the Kenya Information Communication Act (KICA) Guidelines.

The Kenya Copyright Board requires a cover letter requesting the clearance Certificate accompanied by an affidavit in the form found at <https://copyright.go.ke/downloads/send/10-public-notice-cmos/190-royalty-affidavit.html> accompanied by the documents indicated therein to enable it to issue the Copyright Clearance Certificate.

The request can be dropped at the KECOBO offices, 5th Floor, NHIF Building or posted to P.O. Box 34670-00100 Nairobi. The Certificate will be issued not later than 24 hours of application.
