PUBLIC UPDATE ON THE LICENSED COLLECTING MANAGEMENT ORGANISATIONS (CMOs)

This follows the public notice issued by the board on 4th April, 2025.

Pursuant to Section 46(2) of the Copyright Act 2001, the Board has licensed two CMOs namely Performing and Audio-Visual Rights Society of Kenya (PAVRISK) and KAMP Copyright and related rights limited (KAMP). Take note that MCSK license has been withheld due to their internal disputes.

For uniformity and ease of operations, the two licensed collective Management Organisations (CMOs) are required to collect using an ICT system as below as well as per the consent signed by the two CMOs.

Note:

Pursuant to Section 46(12) of the Copyright Act, it is illegal for any person, group of persons or organizations to carry out royalty collections without a valid license from Kenya copyright Board. It is therefore illegal and Criminal for anyone to issue (MCSK-KAMP: PAVRISK-MCSK, KAMP-MCSK, KAMP-PRISK-MCSK) invoices and or licenses.

For avoidance of doubts, valid invoices and licenses must read PAVRISK or KAMP and be accompanied by a corresponding KRA e-tims certificate. Once an invoice/license has been issued by either CMO, it suffices for avoidance of double payment.
